# 4 Aspect Inspection of Community Learning and Development in Larkhall, South Lanarkshire Council - HMIe Report

A report dated 30 November 2006 by the Executive Director (Education Resources) was submitted on the outcome of the aspect inspection of Community Learning and Development in Larkhall made by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Education (HMIe). The inspection had taken place in June 2003 as part of HMIe's programme to trial the framework and methodology of "How Good is Our Community Learning and Development".

The Services inspected were:-

- aspects of Regeneration Services in Enterprise Resources
