The appellant was present and represented by W McGonigle, Unite the Union. The Council was represented by L Rhind, Personnel Manager, Community Resources. The Council's representative called witnesses. All parties were heard in relation to the appeal and then withdrew from the meeting.

Councillor Allison, seconded by Councillor Stewart, moved that the grounds of the appeal had been substantiated in part and that the appeal be upheld to the extent that:-

- the appellant be reimbursed for his period of suspension without pay
- the final written warning on his record remain in force

Councillor S Wardhaugh, seconded by Councillor Holman, moved as an amendment that the grounds of the appeal had been substantiated in part and that the appeal be upheld to the extent that:-

- the appellant be reimbursed for his period of suspension without pay
- the final written warning on his record be replaced with a written warning

On a vote being taken by a show of hands, 3 members voted for the motion and 3 for the amendment. On the casting vote of the Chair, the motion was declared carried.

# The Panel decided:

that the grounds of the appeal had been substantiated in part and the appeal be upheld to the extent that:-

- the appellant be reimbursed for his period of suspension without pay
- the final written warning on his record remain in force
