1 Declaration of Interests

2 Urgent Business

3 Exclusion of Press and Public

The Panel decided:

4 Appeal Against Dismissal

The Panel considered an appeal (Ref 2/21) by an employee against their dismissal.

The Council called a witness and the appellant's representative called the appellant. All parties were heard in relation to the appeal and then withdrew from the meeting.

- the appellant be issued with a final written warning and demoted with effect from the date of dismissal
- ♦ a period of unpaid suspension be applied from the date of dismissal until 28 May 2021
