6 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (As Amended) - Consideration of Suspension or Revocation of Private Hire Car Driver's Licence No 661

A report dated 6 April 2021 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted:-

- ♦ advising on action taken, in terms of Standing Order No 36(c), in view of the timescales involved and a serious threat to public order or safety, by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair and an ex officio member, to order the immediate suspension of private hire car driver's licence No 661, with effect from 6 April 2021
- proposing that consideration be given to whether private hire car driver's licence No 661 should be suspended or revoked

In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended), the opportunity of a hearing had been offered to the licence holder who was present and represented by P Farrell, Solicitor. Y Tedla was in attendance to support the licence holder. A complaint had been received from Police Scotland and Sergeant Rankin was heard.

The Committee decided:

- (1) that the action taken, in terms of Standing Order No 36(c), by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair and an ex officio member, to suspend private hire car driver's licence No 661, with effect from 6 April 2021, for a maximum period of 6 weeks, be noted; and
- (2) that private hire car driver's licence No 661 for the Cambuslang and Rutherglen zone be suspended with immediate effect for the remainder of the period of licence.
