1. Purpose of Report

1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-

- ♦ consider the application by J Watson, 10 Woodside Avenue, Carstairs ML11 8RT for the grant of a street trader's licence in the Clydesdale zone.

3.1. Before a person can operate as a street trader, they require to apply to the Council for the appropriate licence.

3.2. In terms of the legislation, "street trading" means doing any of the following things in a public place:-

- (a) hawking, selling or offering or exposing for sale any article;
- (b) offering to carry out or carrying out for money or money's worth any service to any person in a public place.

3.3. In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, each application requires to be dealt with on its own merits.

4. Present Position

4.1. Mr Watson has applied for a street trader's licence to take over from a current licensee who will surrender her licence if Mr Watson's is granted.
