Subject: Education Resources - Workforce Monitoring – September to November 2009

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-
 - provide employment information for September, October and November 2009 relating to Education Resources

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
 - (1) that the following employment information for September, October and November 2009 relating to Education Resources be noted:-
 - attendance statistics
 - occupational health
 - accidents/incident statistics
 - discipline, grievance and Dignity at Work
 - analysis of leavers
 - Staffing Watch as at 12 September 2009

3. Background

3.1. As part of the Council's performance management arrangements, regular Workforce Monitoring Reports are submitted to Committee. This report for Education Resources provides information on the position for September, October and November 2009.

4. Monitoring Statistics

4.1. Attendance Statistics (Appendix 1) Information on absence statistics are analysed for the most recent month of November 2009 for Education Resources.

The Resource absence figure for November 2009 was 4.8%, an increase of 1.1% from last month and is comparable with the Council Wide figure. Compared with November 2008 the Resource absence figure has increased by 0.1%.

Based on annual trends and the period November 2009, the annual average figure for the Resource equates to 4%, this figure is comparable when compared against the Council wide average.

For the Resource this equates to 8.5 days being lost per employee for the year due to absence compared with the figure for the Council of 9.3 days per employee.

4.2 Occupational Health (Appendix 2)

In terms of referrals to occupational health, which include medical examinations and physiotherapy, overall 195 referrals were made this period, an increase of 5 when compared to the same period last year.

4.3 Accident/Incident Statistics

There were 140 accidents/incidents recorded within the Resource this period, an increase of 62 when compared with the same period last year. 121 of the incidents reported in this period were classified as violent incidents and of these incidents, 63 were due to behavioural incidents. Of the remaining 58 incidents, 37 were physical and 21 were verbal.

4.4 Discipline/Grievance and Dignity at Work

There were 4 disciplinary hearings held within the Resource this period, an increase of 1 when compared with the same period last year. There were no grievances or Dignity at Work cases held within the Resource this period.

4.5 Analysis of Leavers

There were 21 leavers in the Resource this period, a decrease of 10 when compared with the same period last year.

5 Staffing Watch

5.1 There has been a decrease of 79 employees in post since 13 June 2009 to 12 September 2009.

6. Employee Implications

6.1 There are no implications for employees arising from the information presented in this report.

7. Financial Implications

7.1 All financial implications are accommodated within existing budgets.

8. Other Implications

8.1 None
