1. Purpose of Report

1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-

◆ provide information on the progress of the capital programme for Housing and Technical Resources (HRA) for the period 1 April 2009 to 19 March 2010.

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):
 - that the Housing and Technical Resources (HRA) capital programme of £40.441 million, and expenditure to date of £34.031 million be noted.

3. Background

- 3.1. This is the fourth capital monitoring report presented to the Housing and Technical Resources Committee for the financial year 2009/2010.
- 3.2. The report details the financial position for Housing and Technical Resources (HRA) on Appendix A.

4. Employee Implications

4.1. None

5. Financial Implications

5.1. The total capital programme for Housing and Technical Resources (HRA) for 2009/2010 is £40.441million. Anticipated spend to date was £40.441million, and £34.031million has been spent (84.15% of full budget). This represents a position of £6.410million behind profile. Current estimates suggest an outturn for the full year of £38.941million, which is £1.500million less than budget. This is mainly due to recent adverse weather conditions. This time last year £32.799million was spent (85.10%).

6. Other Implications

6.1. The main risk associated with the Council's Capital Programme is failure to manage the projects resulting in a significant overspend. The risk has been assessed as low given the detailed project management plans prepared and monitored for each project. The risk of an overspend is managed through 4 weekly Investment Management Meetings.

7. Equality Impact Assessment and Consultation Arrangements

- 7.1. This report does not introduce a new policy, function or strategy or recommend a change to existing policy, function or strategy and therefore no impact assessment is required.
- 7.2. There was also no requirement to undertake any consultation in terms of the information contained in this report.
