Subject: Enterprise Resources - Capital Budget Monitoring 2010/2011

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-
 - provide information on the progress of the capital programme for Enterprise Resources for the period 1 April 2010 to 1 October 2010.

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
 - (1) that the Enterprise Resources capital programme of £26.646million, and expenditure to date of £10.461million be noted.

3. Background

- 3.1. This is the second capital monitoring report presented to the Enterprise Resources Committee for the financial year 2010/2011. Further reports will follow throughout the financial year.
- 3.2. The report details the financial position for Enterprise Resources in Appendix A.

5. Financial Implications

5.1. The total capital programme for Enterprise Resources for 2010/2011 is £26.646million. Anticipated spend to date was £10.711million with £10.461million of expenditure being incurred (39.26% of full budget). This represents a position of £0.250million behind profile. This time last year £11.014million was spent (35.06%).

6. Other Implications

6.1. The main risk associated with the Council's Capital Programme is failure to manage the projects resulting in a significant overspend. The risk has been assessed as low given the detailed project management plans prepared and monitored for each project. The risk of an overspend is managed through 4 weekly Investment Management Meetings.

7. Equality Impact Assessment and Consultation Arrangements
