1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-
 - provide information on the progress of the capital programme for Finance and Information Technology Resources for the period 1 April 2010 to 1 October 2010.

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):
 - that the Finance and Information Technology Resources capital programme of £0.697million, and expenditure to date of £0.118million be noted.

3. Background

- 3.1. This is the second capital monitoring report presented to the Finance and Information Technology Resources Committee for the financial year 2010/2011. Further reports will follow throughout the financial year.
- 3.2. The report details the financial position for Finance and Information Technology Resources on Appendix A.

5. Financial Implications

5.1. The total capital programme for Finance and Information Technology Resources for 2010/2011 is £0.697million. Anticipated spend to date was £0.204million with £0.118million of expenditure being incurred (16.93% of full budget). This represents a position of £0.086million behind profile. This time last year £0.754million was spent (48.36%).

6. Other Implications

6.1. The main risk associated with the Council's Capital Programme is failure to manage the projects resulting in a significant overspend. The risk has been assessed as low given the detailed project management plans prepared and monitored for each project. The risk of an overspend is managed through 4 weekly Investment Management Meetings.
