3 Regeneration Services Activity in the Cambuslang and Rutherglen Area Committee Area

A report dated 3 May 2011 by the Executive Director (Enterprise Resources) was submitted providing an update on activity being undertaken by Regeneration Services with specific reference to activity within the Cambuslang and Rutherglen Area Committee area.

Details of the activity being undertaken by the 4 teams which made up the Service were provided as follows:-

Community Regeneration and Rural Development

- programme of activity to tackle poverty in South Lanarkshire's most disadvantaged communities. The new Tackling Poverty Programme had come into effect on 1 April 2011 and would direct support towards early intervention, employability support, vulnerable families, financial inclusion and health improvement
- work underway in Cambuslang Park following awards from the Heritage Lottery Fund and The Naked Heart Foundation
- Whitebox Digital, a training/employment provider which identified community project placements for apprentices
- range of environmental projects supported by Pride of Place

Regeneration and Inclusion

- Routes to Inclusion
- range of programmes operating within the area including Future Jobs Fund, Routes to Work South, Connect 2, Rebuilding Opportunities and Youth Jobs Fund
- Community and Voluntary Sector support and role played by the new, single voluntary sector interface, Voluntary Action South Lanarkshire (VASLAN)

Business Support and Property Information

- role played in the Council's response to the economic downturn including working with the Business Gateway Programme
- promotion of business support initiatives such as the West of Scotland Loan Fund, Lanarkshire Sustainable Business Programme, Lanarkshire Property Advice Service and Lanarkshire Business Training Support
- promoting maximum uptake of the Small Business Rates Relief Scheme
- success of local companies at the Lanarkshire Business Excellence Awards

Property Development

- support for partners with the promotion and implementation of projects designed to enhance the attractiveness of the area as a place to work, live and do business including:-
 - Urban Regeneration Company activities in relation to Shawfield and Rutherglen Town Centre. Opening of Red Tree Business Centre scheduled for June 2011
 - Cathcart Place Industrial Estate, Burgh Business Centre and Clydesmill Business Park
 - Community Asset Transfer Scheme pilot
