## **1** Declaration of Interests

#### 2 Exclusion of Press and Public

## **3** Community Resources – Appeal Against Dismissal

The Panel considered an appeal (14/04) by a former employee of Community Resources against his dismissal.

The appellant was present and represented by K Downie, General Municipal Boilermakers. The Council was represented by K McVeigh, Personnel Services Manager, Community Resources. Both sides called witnesses. All parties were heard in relation to the appeal and then withdrew from the meeting.

#### The Panel decided:

that the grounds of the appeal had been substantiated in part and the appeal be upheld to the extent that:-

- the dismissal be substituted by a period of unpaid suspension from the date of dismissal to 30 November 2004 inclusive
- the appellant be required to successfully complete the Employee Counselling Service assistance programme
