5 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (As Amended) – Application for a Booking Office Licence

A report dated 16 January 2020 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted on an application for a booking office licence in terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended).

In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended), the opportunity of a hearing had been offered to the applicant who was not present but was represented by J McCafferty, H Morgan and M Morgan. An objection had been received from Hamilton TOA Radio Cabs, and J McColl and R Hurlbert were heard. An objection had also been received from C Dornan, What in Carnation.
