1 Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to:
 - provide employment information for the period June, July and August 2011 relating to Social Work Resources:

3 Background

3.1 As part of the Council's performance management arrangements, regular Workforce Monitoring Reports are submitted to Committee. This report for Social Work Resources provides information on the position for the period June, July and August 2011.

4 Monitoring Statistics

4.1 Attendance Statistics (Appendix 1)
Information on absence statistics are analysed for the most recent month of August 2011 for Social Work Resources.

The Resource absence figure for August 2011 was 3.8%, a decrease of 0.1% when compared with last month and is 0.9% higher than the Council wide figure. Compared to August 2010 the Resource absence figure has decreased by 0.1%.

Based on annual trends and the absence rate for August 2011, the average absence rate for the Resource for the financial year 2011/2012 is 4% as against a Council

wide average of 3.7%.

For the Resource this equates to 8.6 days being lost per employee for the year, due to absence, compared with the overall figure for the Council of 7.7 days.

4.2 Occupational Health (Appendix 2)

In terms of referrals to occupational health, which include medical examinations and physiotherapy, overall 265 referrals were made this period, an increase of 23 when compared to the same period last year.

4.3 Accident/Incident Statistics

There were 31 accidents/incidents recorded within the Resource this period, this figure remains unchanged when compared with the same period last year.

4.4 Discipline, Grievance and Dignity at Work

During the period there were 26 disciplinary hearings held within the Resource this period. There were no grievance or dignity at work hearings held within the Resource during this period.

4.5 Analysis of Leavers

There were 24 leavers in the Resource this period, an increase of 13 from the same period last year. Exit interviews were held with 19 of those employees.

5 Staffing Watch

There has been a decrease of 25 in the number of employees in post since 12 March 2011 to 11 June 2011

6 Employee Implications

6.1 There are no implications for employees arising from the information presented in this report.

7 Financial Implications

7.1 All financial implications are accommodated within existing budgets.

8 Other Implications
