Subject: Blacklaw and Whitelees Renewable Energy Fund -

Grants Awarded Update

1. Purpose of Report

1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-

 report on grants awarded to date by Blacklaw and Whitelees Renewable Energy Funds

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
 - (1) that the grant awards from the Blacklaw Renewable Energy Fund since inception be noted as detailed within Appendices A and B.
 - that the grant awards from the Whitelees Renewable Energy Fund to date be noted as detailed within Appendices C and D.

3. Background

- 3.1. At the Executive Committee of 3 March, 2004, approval was given to set up a Renewable Energy Fund in respect of Blacklaw Windfarm and to administrative arrangements associated with the allocation of funds.
- 3.2. The Fund is financed from payments from Scottish Power who operate the Blacklaw Windfarm. To date Scottish Power has made payments into the Fund totalling £875,585.62 including interest.
- 3.3 At the Enterprise Resources Committee of 27 June, 2007, approval was given to set up a Renewable Energy Fund in respect of Whitelees Windfarm and to the administrative arrangements associated with the allocation of funds.
- 3.4. The Fund is financed from payments from Scottish Power who operate the Whitelees Windfarm. To date Scottish Power has made payments into the Whitelees Fund of £543,821.93 including interest.
- 3.5. The Section 75 legal agreement for Whitelees places an obligation on the Council to jointly prepare and implement an access strategy associated with the windfarm area.
- 3.6. The Renewable Energy Funds are administered by Regeneration Services who have responsibility for advising potential applicants, assessing applications and monitoring projects to ensure that the community benefits associated with each project are delivered.

4. Projects Approved to Date

- 4.1. A list of all projects supported to date by the Blacklaw Renewable Energy Fund is attached along with details of grant paid / awarded. Appendix A lists those capital projects with overall costs above £10,000 and which are supported through the main fund. Appendix B lists those capital projects with overall costs below £10,000 and which are supported through the Local Grant Scheme, managed through the EU funded LEADER Programme.
- 4.2. A list of all projects supported to date by the Whitelees Renewable Energy Fund is attached along with details of grant paid / awarded. Appendix C lists those capital projects with overall costs above £10,000 and which are supported through the main fund. Appendix D lists those capital projects with overall costs below £10,000 and which are supported through the Local Grant Scheme.

5. Employee Implications

5.1. There are no employee implications.

6. Financial Implications

- 6.1. To date Scottish Power has made payments into the Blacklaw Fund of £875,585.62 including interest i.e. a £849,284.79 contribution and £26,300.83 interest.
- 6.2. Blacklaw has committed funds, from the main Fund, of £592,453 towards projects from an available budget of £620,800.14 (70% of the total £849,284.73 plus interest of £26,300.83).
- 6.3. The Local Grant Scheme (30% of the total £849,284.79 excluding interest) has awarded grants of £128,828.12 from an available budget of £254,785.
- 6.4. To date, Scottish Power has made payments into the Whitelees Fund of £543,821.93 including interest i.e. a £529,580.36 contribution and £14,241.57 interest.
- 6.5. At the Enterprise Resources Committee of 27 June, 2007, approval was given to utilise 31 months of income (£265,248.43) from Whitelees REF towards the access works required and associated costs. This equates to an available budget total for the REF of £264,331.93
- 6.6. Whitelees REF has committed funds, from the main Fund, of £170,636 towards projects from an available budget of £199,273.92 (70% of the available budget of £264,331.93 plus interest of £14,241.57).
- 6.8. The Local Grant Scheme has awarded grants of £21,681.10 from an available budget of £79,299.

7. Other Implications

7.1. There are no risks to the Council associated with this report. Any monies which are not expended on approved projects are returned to increase the available monies for future projects.

8. Equality Impact Assessment and Consultation Arrangements

- 8.1. This Report does not introduce a new policy, function or strategy and, therefore, no impact assessment is required.
- 8.2 All necessary consultation has taken place with community groups involved and appropriate Council Resources.
