# 1. Purpose of Report

1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-

- provide information on the actual expenditure measured against the revenue budget for the period 1 April 2010 to 21 January 2011
- provide a forecast for the year to 31 March 2011.

### 2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Board is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):
  - that an underspend of £0.076m on Lanarkshire Valuation Joint Board's revenue budget, as detailed in Appendix A of the report, be noted
  - that following a probable outturn exercise, the forecast of a £0.081m underspend which will be transferred to Reserves at 31 March 2011, be noted.

### 3. Background

- 3.1. This is the fourth revenue budget monitoring report presented to the Lanarkshire Valuation Joint Board for the financial year 2010/2011.
- 3.2. The report details the financial position for Lanarkshire Valuation Joint Board on Appendix A.

### 5. Financial Implications

- 5.1. As at 29 October 2010, the variance from phased budget to date is a £0.076m underspend.
- 5.2. The financial forecast, following a probable outturn exercise, to 31 March 2011 is a £0.081m underspend.

# 6. Other Implications

6.1. The main risk associated with the Board's Revenue Budget is failure to manage the budget resulting in a significant overspend. The risk has been assessed as low given the detailed budget management applied. The risk is managed by the preparation of 4 weekly Budget Monitoring Reports where any variance is analysed. In addition, the probable outturn exercise ensures early warning for corrective action to be taken where appropriate.

# 7. Equality Impact Assessment and Consultation Arrangements

- 7.1. This report does not introduce a new policy, function or strategy or recommend a change to an existing policy, function or strategy and therefore no impact assessment is required.
- 7.2. There is also no requirement to undertake any consultation in terms of the information contained in the report.
