Subject: Review of Trust Funds

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-
 - ◆ Inform Committee of the processes that will be followed when reviewing active and inactive trusts to ensure intended recipients benefit fully

3. Background

- 3.1. A report was submitted to Finance and Information Technology Resources on 30 September 2008 to inform Committee of expenditure incurred by various trust funds during 2007/08 and to advise Committee of inactive funds as at 31 March 2008.
- 3.2. Committee was asked to approve work to commence on reviewing active and inactive trusts to ensure intended recipients benefit fully.
- 3.3. This paper is intended to outline the processes that will be followed during this review.

4. Process of Reviewing Trust Funds

- 4.1. The first stage in reviewing the Trust Funds will be to attempt to determine the original purpose or intent of the Trust Funds. In order to do so the original trust deeds or notes from the former district councils will be examined. It is anticipated that in some cases documented evidence of the original purpose or intent of the Trust Funds will not be available. A list of the Trusts that will be reviewed is attached to this paper at Appendix 1.
- 4.2. Where the original purpose or intent of the Trust Fund cannot be determined advice will be sought from the Council's Legal services and with the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator (OSCR) to identify what options we have for managing these Trusts.

- 4.3. There are currently a number of different methods used to determine how Trust beneficiaries are selected, and how the funds are distributed. There are also some trusts which are inactive. Options for actively managing and reporting on the Trusts will be investigated. The aim is to ensure that we get the most out of the Trust Funds that we hold.
- 4.4. OSCR had previously notified us of an option which may allow the consolidation of existing trusts in order to achieve maximum benefit for the recipients. This option will be investigated and findings reported back to this Committee. Advice from OSCR and Legal Services will be sought throughout this investigation.
- 4.5. The expected outcome for the review will be an agreed strategy for the continued management of Trust Funds within the council, documenting how each Trust is to be used.
- 4.6. A further report on the progress of this review will be made to Finance and IT Resources Committee in July 2009.
