2 Minutes of Previous Meeting

3 Scottish Fire and Rescue Service

E Kelly, Station Manager, East Kilbride Community Fire Station, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service gave a presentation on the development of a new Local Fire and Rescue Plan for South Lanarkshire.

The presentation highlighted that:-

 the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service Strategic Plan 2016 to 2019 encapsulated the Service's mission, values and priorities and focused on shaping a fire and rescue service to meet Scotland's future challenges

- the Strategic Plan instigated a mandatory requirement to review all current Local Fire and Rescue Plans
- a performance review of the priorities in the current Local Fire and Rescue Plan for South Lanarkshire 2014 to 2017 had been undertaken
- feedback from stakeholders had shaped the content of the new Local Fire and Rescue Plan

Information was provided on the priorities in the South Lanarkshire Local Plan 2017 which were as follows:-

- to reduce the number of accidental fires and fire related injuries within the home
- to reduce the impact of unintentional injury and harm within the home
- to reduce the number of fires within non-domestic properties
- to reduce the number of instances of fire related anti-social behaviour
- to reduce the number of unwanted fire alarm signals
- to reduce the impact of road traffic collisions
- operational resilience and preparedness

Station Manager Kelly, having responded to members' questions, was thanked for his informative presentation.
