7 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (As Amended) – Application for Grant of Private Hire Car Driver's Licence

A report dated 19 September 2023 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted on an application for the grant of a private hire car driver's licence in terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended).

The Legal Services' Adviser intimated that the applicant had been given the deadline of Friday 6 October 2023 to pass his route test. All applicants were required to pass a route test before a licence could be granted. As the applicant had failed to pass the route test by the deadline date, the application had to be refused.

Court, Glasgow for the grant of a private hire car driver's licence had been refused as he had failed to pass his route

test.
