Ms Scott and Ms Paterson provided background information on the Comenius Regio Project, a bilateral project being taken forward with an identified partner in Norway to improve literacy levels, and their schools' involvement in the project to date. The pupils from both schools delivered a presentation on their contact with the partner schools in Norway and the links being developed.

Having highlighted differences in the approach to education in each country and having responded to members' questions, the teachers and pupils were commended on their informative and interesting presentation.
