Trust Fund Expenditure 2008/09

Report

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-
 - Inform Committee of distributions made from the Trust Funds administered by the Council during 2008/09 and of inactive funds as at 31 March 2009.

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
 - (1) That the content of the report is noted

3. Background

- 3.1. South Lanarkshire Council administers a total of 110 Trust Funds. The value of these Trust Funds as at 31 March 2009 was £0.873m.
- 3.2. This paper is intended to inform Committee of payments made from the Trust Funds during 2008/09 and the remaining balance on the fund as at 31 March 2009.
- 3.3. The paper also details funds that over the years have become dormant and from which no expenditure has been incurred recently. The balance on these funds at 31 March 2009 was £0.036m.

4. Distribution of Trust Funds

- 4.1. Generally Trust Funds are managed in such a way as to maintain the capital value of the fund, ensuring that recipients can continue to benefit from these funds in future years. This is done by restricting annual expenditure to be no more than annual income.
- 4.2. The majority of Trust Funds are distributed to the same groups or institutions each year. There are also a small number of funds which distribute funds to individuals. The lists of Trust Fund recipients have built up over time where, historically, recipients were proposed by Social Work, or by local Councillors. No new recipients have been sought for 08/09.
- 4.3. Education Trust Funds are mainly distributed by making payment to the relevant school fund. Once again this method of distribution has been long established.

- 4.4. The most significant trust fund is the Loudon Bequest that is used to finance holiday projects for older people and is distributed to the former authorities of Strathclyde Regional Council in accordance with the proportion of vulnerable elderly people in each authority. At 31 March 2009 the balance on the Loudon Bequest was £0.572m.
- 4.5. Appendix 1 shows all active funds, payments made in 2008/2009 and the balances of the funds as at 31 March 2009.

5. Inactive Funds

- 5.1. There is currently £0.036m held in Trusts which are currently inactive with no payments being made from fund balances. These are detailed in Appendix 2.
- 5.2. These funds have become inactive for a number of reasons, including the purpose of the trust being unclear but for many the dormant nature of the trust is historical with no decisions being taken on recipients. These inactive funds will be included as one of the main focus areas of a review of trust funds currently underway.

6. Future Administration of Trust Funds

6.1. This Committee has previously approved a review of Trust Funds. The aim of this review is to examine all trusts including inactive trust with the aim of ensuring that the Trusts provide the best value to their recipients. Ongoing governance of the trusts will also be included in the Review. The review is nearing completion, and a final report outlining the findings and proposed changes will be brought back to this committee on 27 October 2009.

8. Financial Implications

8.1. In 2008/09 Trust Funds were administered in such a manner that the capital value of the fund was preserved. This ensured that the funds were available to benefit recipients in years to come.
