- heard J McLean and W McNeil, representing Carluke No Surrender Apprentice Boys of Derry
- considered written representations from Police Scotland who was represented by Inspector McCallum
- considered written representations from Roads and Transportation Services who were represented by S Simpson, Assistant Engineering Officer
