Councillor Buchanan, seconded by Councillor Brian McCaig, moved by way of amendment that the appeal had been substantiated in part and the appeal be upheld to the extent that:-

- the dismissal be substituted by a period of unpaid absence from the date of dismissal to 3 December 2006 inclusive
- the appellant be issued with a final written warning

On a vote being taken by a show of hands, 2 members voted for the motion and 3 for the amendment which was declared carried.
