Thank you for your letter of 3rd October.

With reference to this letter, I would like to comment on Point 3.

I maintain our application does not differ significantly from the examples provided. I would argue that the settlement pattern for Whyte Avenue is as irregular as the example provided for Blantyre. Properties in the adjacent Fraser Street, Cathkin Avenue and Quarry Place back onto each other and partially wrap round adjacent plots. Likewise for the Boghead example there appears to be one property sited to the rear of existing properties. However I have cited examples of properties in Whyte Avenue with limited road frontage (nos 17-23 and 18-24) and in the adjacent Fraser Street, nos. 64,66 and 68 have no road frontage whatsoever.

Furthermore, I do not consider it is acceptable to state each planning application should be determined on its own merits and different planning officers may offer varying interpretations on major points of policy. I consider such a flexible strategy can lead to a perceived unfairness in the planning process.
