3.1. The Council operates a community grants scheme to support local constituted community groups and voluntary organisations. Applications are invited continually through the year.

All applications require to be supported by a constitution, audited accounts and a bank statement.

5. Financial Implications

5.1. The current position of the community grant allocation for the East Kilbride Area in 2010/2011 is as follows:-

Total allocation for Community Grants	£56,000
Grants allocated so far	£37,644
Community Grants recommended in this report	£12,695
Remaining balance	£5,661

5.2. In view of the fact that this is the last meeting of the Committee in the current financial year and to allow any remaining balance in 2010/2011 community grant budget to be utilised, it is proposed that the Executive Director (Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair, be authorised to approve any further community grant applications meeting the relevant criteria in the period to 31 March 2011. Those grants awarded would be reported to the next meeting of the Committee for noting.

6. Other Implications

6.1. The risk to the Council is that grant funding is not utilised for the purpose of which it was intended. This risk is mitigated by internal controls including audit procedures and a conditions of grant agreement.

6.2. There are no apparent implications in terms of sustainable development.

- 7.1. This report does not introduce a new policy, function or strategy or recommend a change to an existing policy, function or strategy and therefore no impact assessment is required.
