RADON IN HOMES IN SOUTH LANARKSHIRE COUNCIL

The Scottish Government has commissioned Public Health England (PHE) to work with South Lanarkshire Council to identify and reduce high levels of radon in homes. Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas and prolonged exposure to high levels is linked with the increase of risk of lung cancer, especially in smokers.

Your home is in an area where the levels in some homes could be above the Action Level, and as such, you are eligible for a free radon test. To receive your free test, please complete the form below and return it to PHE using the prepaid envelope. The radon measurement is simple to use and includes instructions. The result of the test, along with advice, will be sent to you directly and will be shared with South Lanarkshire Council. If a high level of radon is found in your home, relatively simple steps can be taken to reduce it. Please help us to assess the risk from radon in your area and find out if you need to reduce the radon health risk to your family.
