4 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (As Amended) - Consideration of Suspension or Revocation of Private Hire Car Driver's Licence No 167

A report dated 6 April 2022 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted:-

advising on action taken, in terms of Standing Order No 36(c), in view of the timescales involved and a serious threat to public order or safety, by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair and an ex officio member, to order the immediate suspension of private hire car driver's licence No 167, with effect from 21 March 2022

 proposing that consideration be given to whether private hire car driver's licence No 167 should be suspended or revoked

In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended), the opportunity of a hearing had been offered to the licence holder who was not present or represented. A complaint had been received from Police Scotland.

The Committee decided:

- (1) that the action taken, in terms of Standing Order No 36(c), by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair and an ex officio member, to suspend private hire car driver's licence No 167, with effect from 21 March 2022, for a maximum period of 6 weeks, be noted; and
- (2) that private hire car driver's licence No 167 for the East Kilbride zone be suspended with immediate effect for the remainder of the period of licence.
