5.1. The current position of the community grant allocation for the East Kilbride Area in 2011/2012 is as follows:-

- 6.1. The risk to the Council is that grant funding is not utilised for the purpose of which it was intended. This risk is mitigated by internal controls including audit procedures and a conditions of grant agreement.
