## 4 Twinning Grant Application - Larkhall Twinning Association

A report dated 25 May 2007 by the Executive Director (Corporate Resources) was submitted on an application by Larkhall Twinning Association for a twinning travel grant which had been assessed as meeting the relevant criteria.
