2 Minutes of Previous Meeting

3 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 - Licensing of Taxis - Review of Taxi Fares - East Kilbride Zone

A report dated 19 May 2010 by the Executive Director (Corporate Resources) was submitted on a request from East Kilbride Taxi Operators' Association for additional items to be included in the fares review.

Proposals in respect of the current review had been approved by this Committee at its meeting on 12 May 2010 subject to no objections being received.

Additional amendments to the fares card had since been requested by East Kilbride Taxi Operators' Association. Those involved:-

- a change to the fares card to indicate that fares beyond the area of East Kilbride zone may be subject to a surcharge of 1/3 of the normal metered fare as opposed to the current position where this would be subject to special agreement in advance with the hirer
- the charge for when a hired car was called but not used increasing to £2.50
- removal of the surcharge of 10 pence for each passenger beyond 2

The Committee decided:

that the additional amendments to the fares card requested by East Kilbride Taxi Operators' Association be approved and the fares review be progressed in line with the previous decision of the Committee.

8 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 - Licensing of Private Hire Cars and Taxi Drivers - Suspension of Licences

A report dated 30 April 2010 by the Executive Director (Corporate Resources) was submitted:-

- advising on action taken, in terms of Standing Order No 36(c), in view of the timescales involved and a serious threat to public order or safety, by the Executive Director (Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair and an ex officio member, to order the immediate suspension of private hire car licence No 033 and taxi driver's licence No 005 with effect from 29 April 2010
- proposing that consideration be given to whether private hire car licence No 033 and taxi driver's licence No 005 should remain suspended

In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, the opportunity of a hearing had been offered to the applicant who was not present or represented. A letter from the applicant's solicitor was presented in support of the licence holder retaining his licences. A complaint had been received from Strathclyde Police and Chief Inspector Kerr was heard.
