5.1. The current position of the community grant allocation for the Cambuslang and Rutherglen Area in 2010/2011 is as follows:-

Total allocation for Community Grants	£56,000
Grants allocated so far	£16,980
Community Grants recommended in this report	£4,500
Remaining balance	£34,520

6. Other Implications

- 6.1. The risk to the Council is that grant funding is not utilised for the purpose of which it was intended. This risk is mitigated by internal controls including audit procedures and a conditions of grant agreement.
- 6.2. There are no apparent implications in terms of sustainable development.
