2 Minutes of Previous Meeting

3 Acquisition of 72 Cathcart Road, Rutherglen

A report dated 21 September 2011 by the Executive Director (Enterprise Resources) was submitted on the acquisition of the former laundry site and buildings at 72 Cathcart Road, Rutherglen from Giffen and Bissett Limited for the provision of further industrial development aimed at promoting economic activity and job creation.

It was proposed that the site and buildings, extending to 0.82 acres, be purchased from Giffen and Bissett Limited, in the sum of £425,000, subject to the terms and conditions detailed in the report.

The Committee decided:

(2) that the Executive Director (Enterprise Resources), in consultation with the Head of Legal Services, be authorised to conclude negotiations and the necessary legal agreements on terms which were in the best interests of the Council.
