Budget 2014/2015

1. Purpose of Report

1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-

 advise members on the base budget for 2014/2015 for Community and Enterprise Resources

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
 - (1) that the current position be noted; and
 - that acceptance of the base budget be endorsed and referred to the Enterprise Services Committee for its consideration.

3. Background

- 3.1. On 11 December 2013, the Scottish Government provided the Council's finance settlement for 2014/2015, which allowed progress on the budget position for 2014/2015 to be made.
- 3.2. At its meeting of 29 January 2014, the Executive Committee approved a package of savings for 2014/2015 which includes the £2.892million shown below for Community and Enterprise Resources.

4. Current Position

4.1. Budget Summary

The 2014/2015 base budget for Community and Enterprise Resources is £112.497 million and is detailed at Appendix 1. In summary, the 2013/2014 budget has been adjusted for rollover items (including pay award), as identified in the Financial Strategy, approved savings and any additional funding from the Scottish Government as notified in the December 2013 settlement, to arrive at the 2014/2015 base budget. This is set out as follows overleaf:-
