3 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 - Licensing of Private Hire Car Drivers - S Gardiner, 45 McArthur Wynd, Cambuslang

A report dated 5 September 2007 by the Executive Director (Corporate Resources) was submitted:-

- advising on action taken, in terms of Standing Order No 36(c) due to the timescales involved, by the Executive Director (Corporate Resources), in consultation with the Chair and an ex officio member, to suspend private hire car driver's licence No 477 held by S Gardiner, 45 McArthur Wynd, Cambuslang pending consideration of the issue by the Committee
- proposing that consideration be given to whether private hire car driver's licence No 477 should remain suspended

who presented information in support of the licence holder retaining his licence. An objection by Strathclyde Police was heard.
