3 HMIe Report - St Bride's Primary School and Nursery Class, Cambuslang

A report dated 23 March 2010 by the Executive Director (Education Resources) was submitted on the outcome of the inspection of St Bride's Primary School and Nursery Class, Cambuslang made by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Education (HMIe).

The inspection had taken place in January 2010 as part of a national sample of primary and nursery education and the inspection report had been published on 9 March 2010.
