## 5 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (As Amended) – Application for Grant of a Street Trader's Licence

A report dated 30 December 2019 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted on an application for the grant of a street trader's licence in terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended).

At its meeting on 3 December 2019, the Committee agreed that this application be continued to a future meeting to allow the applicant the opportunity to be present.

In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended), the opportunity of a hearing had been offered to the applicant who was not present or represented. A representation had been received from Police Scotland.

Councillor McLachlan, seconded by Councillor Marrs, moved that the application be refused. Councillor McGuigan, seconded by Councillor Donnelly, moved as an amendment that the application be granted. On a vote being taken by a show of hands, 6 members voted for the amendment and 14 for the motion which was declared carried.

## 6 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (As Amended) - Consideration of Suspension or Revocation of Private Hire Car Driver's Licence No 324

A report dated 30 December 2019 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted proposing that consideration be given to whether private hire car driver's licence No 324 should be suspended or revoked.

In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended), the opportunity of a hearing had been offered to the licence holder who was present and heard in support of retaining his licence. A letter of complaint and an updated email had been received from Police Scotland and Sergeant Rankin was heard.

Councillor Shearer, seconded by Councillor Logan, moved that the licence be suspended with immediate effect for a period of 2 weeks. Councillor McLachlan, seconded by Councillor Horsham, moved as an amendment that the licence be not suspended or revoked. On a vote being taken by a show of hands, 8 members voted for the amendment and 10 voted for the motion which was declared carried.

immediate effect for a period of 2 weeks.
