Subject: Appointment of Convener and Deputy Convener

1. Purpose of Report

1.1 To indicate to members the procedure to be followed by the Authority in appointing its Convener and Deputy Convener from the members appointed by the 2 constituent authorities.

2 Recommendations

2.1 It is recommended that members note the arrangements for the appointment of the Convener and Deputy Convener.

3 Appointment of Convener and Deputy Convener

- 3.1 In terms of The Community Justice Authorities (Establishment, Constitution and Proceedings) (Scotland) Order 2006 the Authority is required to appoint from its membership a Convener and Deputy Convener.
- 3.2 Until the appointment of the Convener the Chair will be occupied, in accordance with the Order, by the oldest member nominated by South Lanarkshire Council. That person will
 - take the sederunt of the members present
 - call for nominations for the position of Convener and will oversee any voting
 - vacate the Chair and the duly appointed Convener will take the Chair and oversee the appointment of the Deputy Convener and the remaining business on the published agenda
