South Lanarkshire Council - Returning Officer for Election Purposes

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-
 - confirm the position regarding the appointment of Chief Executive as Returning Officer for election purposes.

2. Recommendation(s)

- 2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
 - (1) that the post holder of the position of Chief Executive be confirmed as the Returning Officer appointed by the Council for election purposes; and
 - (2) that this appointment be reflected within the Council's Scheme of Delegation.

3. Background

- 3.1. Each council in Scotland must appoint a Returning Officer who is responsible for the organisation of elections within that council's area.
- 3.2 The Returning Officer is an officer of the Council who is appointed under section 41 of the Representation of the People Act 1983. Although appointed by the Council, the role of the Returning Officer is one of a personal nature and distinct and separate from their duties as an employee of the council. The Returning Officer is responsible for:-
 - the nomination process for candidates and political parties
 - provision and notification of polling stations
 - appointment of Presiding Officers and Polling Clerks
 - appropriate administration and security of polling stations
 - preparation of all ballot papers
 - the actual count and declaration of results
 - issue, receipt and counting of postal ballot papers
 - all candidates' election expenses returns
 - presentation of final account
 - reclamation of funding from external bodies as prescribed

4. Appointment of Returning Officer

4.1. In light of the forthcoming retiral of the Chief Executive, Mr Archibald Strang, it is proposed that the incoming Chief Executive, Mr Lindsay Freeland, be appointed as Returning Officer for election purposes.

4.2 In addition, it is proposed that Section 4A of the Scheme of Delegation be amended to reflect this position as follows:-

"to act as Returning Officer for election purposes and fulfil the role of Proper Officer in terms of the requirements of the Representation of the People Act 1983."
