5.1. The total capital programme for Finance and Information Technology Resources for 2008/2009 is £1.974million. Anticipated spend to date was £1.974million with £1.351million of expenditure being incurred (68.4% of full budget). This represents a position of £0.623million behind profile. This time last year £0.787million was spent (43.9%).
