# 3. Background

- 3.1. The Council's community grants scheme includes provision for funding for playschemes operating over the Summer, October and Easter school holiday periods. Applications have been invited from individual playschemes for 2009/2010.
- 3.2. The recommendations reflect the Council's decision to allocate grant funding on the following basis:-
  - £600 to playschemes that operate over the Summer, October and Easter periods
  - £400 for summer period only
  - £100 for each of the October and Easter periods
- 3.3. The Council also makes financial provision for individual playschemes to receive, as appropriate, travel passes from Strathclyde Passenger Transport (SPT) and access to Council transport during the school holiday periods.
