3 Presentation - Strathclyde Police

The representatives from Strathclyde Police gave a presentation on:-

- changes to the Divisional structure and the benefits for the Hamilton Area Committee area
- performance and activity during 2010/2011 which highlighted that there was a continued reduction in recorded crimes and a detection rate of 61.9% in violent crime
- activity undertaken in the course of the year and the proactive approach being adopted to move persons away from criminality
- current initiatives and activities including "Move the Goalposts" and "Operation Cargo" which targeted known drinking hotspots and the "Usual Suspects" knife crime initiative

Chief Superintendent Gall and Chief Inspector Jennings, having responded to members' questions, were thanked for their informative presentation.

4 Hamilton Area Profile 2011

A report dated 6 September 2011 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted on key indicators of conditions in the Hamilton Area Committee area.

The Central Research Unit within Finance and Corporate Resources maintained a website allowing access to a wide range of information at a datazone level. Datazones were neighbourhoods of around 750, produced by the Scottish Government, which allowed data to be analysed and information to be reported on at approximations to a Council ward and Area Committee area basis.

Information was provided on:-

- population projections for the Hamilton area which indicated that the population was expected to fall compared to a rise in South Lanarkshire as a whole. In addition, the growth amongst those aged 80 years and over was expected to be much greater than in South Lanarkshire as a whole
- employment forecasts which indicated that employment would rise over the next 5 years by 0.3%
- population trends and the potential for the Boundary Commission Review to focus on the boundaries for the Hamilton North and East and the Bothwell and Uddingston wards
- the number of people claiming Job Seekers Allowance which in June 2011 was 3,485 giving a claimant rate of 5.3%, a rise of 6.1% since June 2010
- percentage of children in families out of work receiving Child Tax Credit
- percentage of children in families receiving Child Tax Credit
- 'More Choices, More Chances' percentage of school leavers not moving into positive destinations
- percentage of pensioners claiming Pension Credit guarantee element only
- the claimant rate for health related benefits and comparative illness statistics
- all crimes and offences (excluding motoring offences)
