3 HMle Report - St Mary's Primary School, Hamilton

A report dated 25 October 2010 by the Executive Director (Education Resources) was submitted on the outcome of the inspection of St Mary's Primary School, Hamilton made by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Education (HMle).

The inspection had taken place in April 2010 as part of a national sample of primary education and the inspection report had been published on 22 June 2010.

Education Resources' employees would ensure that the recommendations contained within the report were followed up and that appropriate support was made available to the school. In light of the inspection findings, no further visits would be made by HMle in connection with this inspection.

4 HMle Report - Udston Primary School, Hamilton

The inspection had taken place in March 2010 as part of a national sample of primary education and the inspection report had been published on 25 May 2010.

6 Roads Investment Programme - Progress Report
