We also evaluated the following aspects of the work of the school.

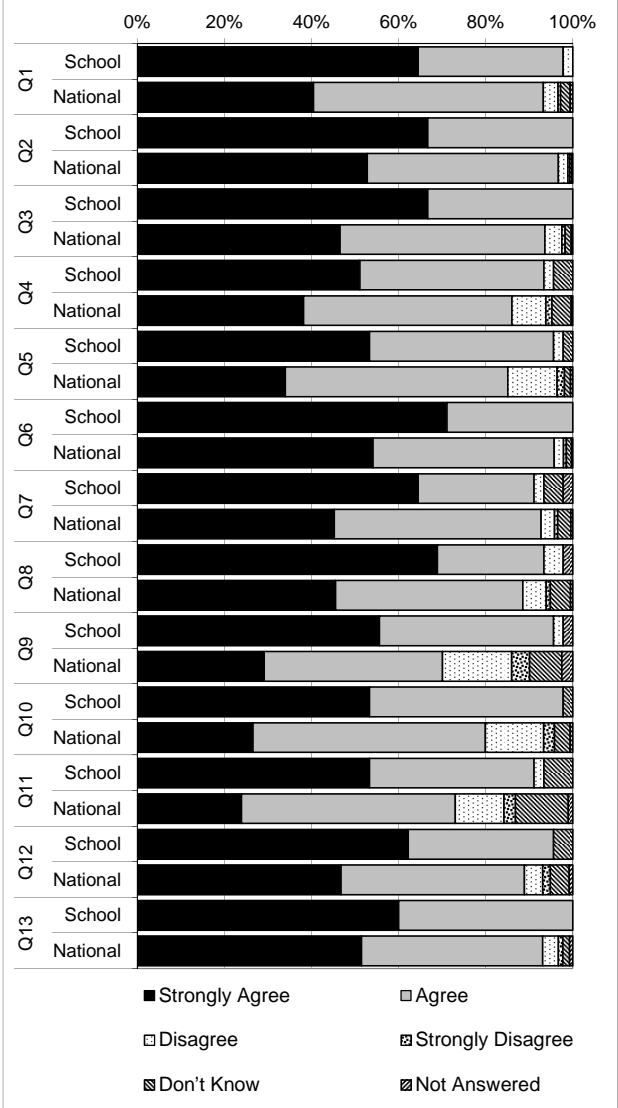

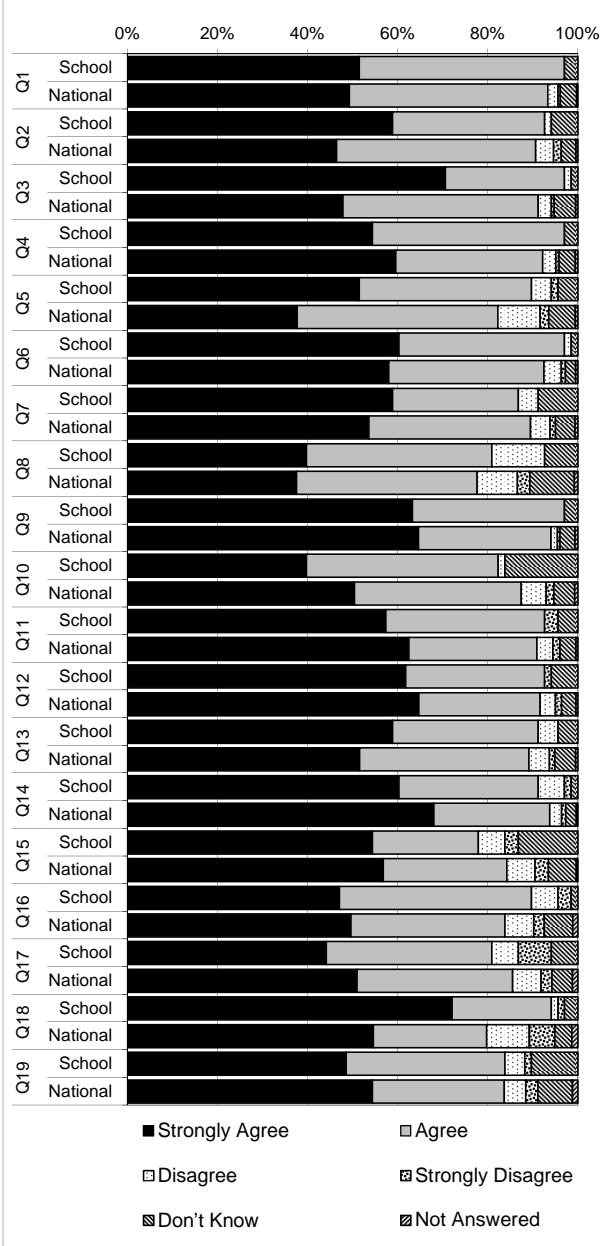

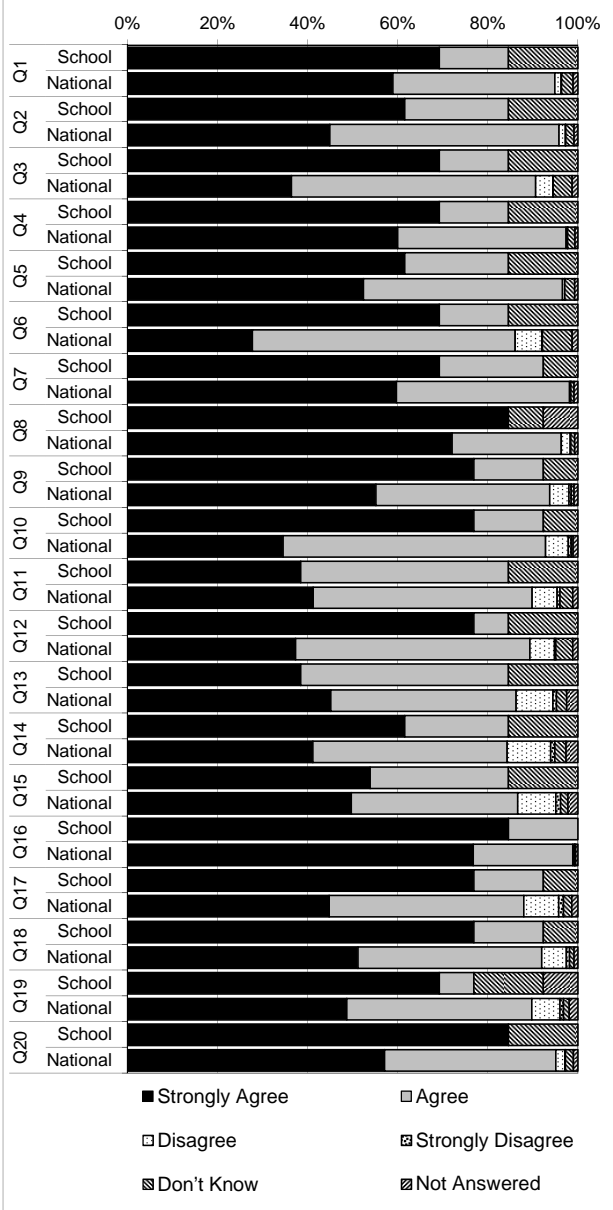
