## 3 Education Scotland Report – Blackwood Primary School and Nursery Class

---

A report dated 10 August 2020 by the Executive Director (Education Resources) was submitted on the outcome of the inspection of Blackwood Primary School and Nursery Class made by Education Scotland.

The inspection had taken place in December 2019 as part of a national sample of primary education and the inspection letter reporting on the findings had been published on 10 March 2020.

A number of particular strengths of the school had been identified in the inspection letter. The areas for improvement, agreed with the school and education authority, had been incorporated into the school's improvement plan and parents would be informed of progress. Education Scotland had intimated that it would make no further visits in connection with this inspection.

C McMillan, Headteacher and G Maguire, Lead Officer (Numeracy and Mathematics), having spoken on key aspects of the report and having responded to members' questions, were congratulated on the positive inspection report.

#### **4 Community Grant Applications**

---

A report dated 10 August 2020 by the Executive Director (Finance and Corporate Resources) was submitted on applications for community grant.

On 1 May 2020, a briefing note had been issued to elected members outlining a proposal to use £20,000 from the 2020/2021 community grant budget to assist community groups engaged in supporting their local communities during the Covid-19 pandemic. The £20,000 would be apportioned between the 4 Area Committee areas. A report on the awards would be submitted to a future meeting of this Committee for noting.

Following a full discussion regarding the Covid-19 funding to support local communities during the pandemic, officers undertook to circulate further information in relation to the grant process and monies spent to all members of this Committee.

**The Committee decided:**

(1) that community grants be awarded as follows:-

- (a) Applicant: Lunar Gymnastics Club, Lesmahagow (CL/9/20)  
Purpose of Grant: Equipment  
Amount Awarded: £750
- (b) Applicant: Biggar and District Community Heritage, Biggar (CL/10/20)  
Purpose of Grant: Equipment, administration and publicity costs  
Amount Awarded: £400
- (c) Applicant: Lanark Area Tenants' and Residents' Association, Lanark (CL/11/20)  
Purpose of Grant: Equipment  
Amount Awarded: £600
- (d) Applicant: Lanark in Bloom (CL/12/20)  
Purpose of Grant: Equipment, administration and publicity costs  
Amount Awarded: £750

Purpose of Grant: Administration and publicity costs  
Amount Awarded: £200
