## 1. Purpose of Report

1.1. The purpose of the report is to:-

- further progress the fares review process in the Cambuslang and Rutherglen and Hamilton zones of South Lanarkshire

2. Recommendation(s)
2.1. The Committee is asked to approve the following recommendation(s):-
(1) agree the proposals for the Cambuslang and Rutherglen zone to increase the cost of the average two mile hire from $£ 5.60$ to $£ 6.60$ and waiting time from $£ 12$ per hour to $£ 15$ per hour as detailed at Appendix 2; and
(2) agree the proposals for the Hamilton zone to increase the cost of the average two mile hire from $£ 5.60$ to $£ 6.00$ and various other increases as detailed at Appendix 4.

## 3. Background

3.1. In terms of Section 17 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended) by Section 174 of the Criminal Justice and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2010 Licensing Authorities must review taxi fares in their area every 18 months.
3.2. At its meeting held on 27 June 2013, the Licensing Committee agreed to calculate all future increases based on an agreed formula.
3.3. As members will be aware, even if there is no increase in the fares tariff, the formal review procedures require to be commenced.

## 4. Present Position

4.1. At its meeting on 22 February 2022 this Committee agreed that, subject to any representations received, the fares review for the Cambuslang and Rutherglen and Hamilton zones would take place on the basis that there would be no increase in the current tariffs.
4.2. At its meeting held on 14 June 2022 this Committee agreed to further consultation with the taxi trade in the Cambuslang and Rutherglen and Hamilton zones after considering representations received from taxi operators in the Hamilton zone. All taxi operators in these zones were again written to seeking their views on any proposed increases in the fares tariff.
4.2. Proposals received in respect of the Cambuslang and Rutherglen zone are detailed in Appendix 1. These proposals are shown on the fares tariff card in Appendix 2.
4.3. Proposals received in respect of the Hamilton zone are detailed in Appendix 3. By way of a petition the majority of the taxi trade are requesting an increase of 40p on the flagfall to bring the cost of the average two mile hire from $£ 5.20$ to $£ 5.60$ and an increase from 60 p to $£ 1.20$ on the surcharge between 10.00 pm and 5.00 am. Various other suggested increases have been shown on Appendix 4.
4.4. The proposed Cambuslang and Rutherglen, Clydesdale, East Kilbride and Hamilton fares reviews have been advertised in the press and on the Council's website in accordance with the legislation and no responses from members of the public were received. Representations were received from taxi operators in the Hamilton zone.
5. Employee Implications
5.1. None.
6. Financial Implications
6.1. The cost of Appeal to the Traffic Commissioner if the decision of the Council is appealed.
7. Climate Change, Sustainability and Environmental Implications
7.1. No assessment of the impact on the environment has been made as the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (as amended) does not allow us to take this into account when determining applications and therefore we would not propose to take this into account in dealing with the statutory review of taxi fares.
8. Other Implications
8.1. The risk to the Council is that it fails to fulfil its duty to protect the public.
9. Equality Impact Assessment and Consultation Arrangements
9.1. There is no requirement to carry out an impact assessment in terms of the proposals contained within this report.
9.2. Consultation was initially carried out with the taxi trade to ascertain views on whether or not they are seeking an increase in taxi fares this year. Adverts were then placed in the press and on the Council's website outlining the proposals for each of the zones giving a period of one month to enable anyone to comment on or object to the proposed changes to the fares tariffs.

(2) a surcharge of $1 / 3^{\text {rd }}$ of the normal metered fare may be charged for each hire from 6am on $24^{\text {th }}$ December until 5am on $27^{\text {th }}$ December and from 6am on $31^{\text {st }}$ December until midnight on $2^{\text {nd }}$ January.
(3) a surcharge, to be specially agreed in advance with the hirer, may be charged for 5 or more passengers hiring a people carrier type car.
(4) a surcharge of 10 pence may be charged for each passenger beyond 2.
