 - (1) that the Terms of Reference for the Climate Change and Sustainability Committee, as detailed in Appendix 1, be approved.

3. Background

- 3.1. At its meeting held on 25 September 2019, the Council agreed that a new committee on climate change and sustainability be established and a Terms of Reference submitted to a future Council meeting for approval.
- 3.2. An update was provided to Council on 4 December 2019 advising that a draft Terms of Reference for the committee would be submitted to the Standards and Procedures Advisory Forum in the first instance prior to being brought to a future meeting of the Council in 2020.
- 3.3. At its meeting held on 9 December 2019, the Standards and Procedures Advisory Forum endorsed the proposed Terms of Reference for the Climate Change and Sustainability Committee, attached as Appendix 1 to the report, which has the same membership as the Executive Committee to reflect the high level status of the committee.
